How Do I get started with this product?

When running Windows ME/2000/XP, Mac OS 9.0 or above, and Linux Kernel 2.4.0, it is not necessary to install the device driver. As soon as the device is connected to a USB port on your computer, the system recognizes it automatically and installs the device driver. No driver is required.

Application Software Timely Updated Online

"Traveling Disk" has a bundled application program, which gives you the function settings in security, boot up and disk partition. Through password setting, data are locked and safe. Through disk partitioning, bad blocks in the flash memory can be recovered and device life cycle and speed can be extended. Furthermore, whenever the disk formatting is done, boot up function is built in the device automatically.

Driver Installation

Particularly for Operating System (OS) under Windows 98SEIf you are using **Windows 98SE**, you have to install the driver bundled with the product to work properly.

Driver CD

Retrieve the driver utility files from the Driver CD and follow below instructions to complete the setting procedure.

Website Download

Please go to www.pqi.com.tw/Download/. Select 'Traveling Disk' from the left hand side menu. Identify your product model for the correct file to download. Drivers are timely updated and available to download from Below shows how to complete the simple steps of driver installation.

How do I install the driver? (For OS Under Windows 98SE)

- Select the folder called "98Driver" which contains the device driver, and execute setup file. The driver will be installed onto your system automatically. A dialog box will then appear and request system reboot. Click "Yes" to reboot, and then plug the device into your USB port.
- Now, enjoy the fun it offers!

How do I Unplug the Device?

To avoid data loss or mechanical damage, do not power down your computer or unplug the device during data transfer. Even when your device is at waiting mode; you still need to follow the instruction. Please see below carefully as different operating systems require different "disconnecting" procedures.

- Windows 98SE: Unplug only when LED is off.
- Windows ME, 2000: Select the "Eject" button of Windows system
- Mac: Throw the "Removable Disk" icon to "Recycle Bin"
- **Linux**: Remove the Disk after 'unmount' command executed.
